Using the ICT equipment correctly and responsibly is very important.

I agree to:

1. use the ICT equipment carefully.
2. only work on the programs and web pages that my teacher tells me to use.
3. keep my password a secret.
4. ask for help if I do not understand what to do.
5. tell my teacher if I read or see something on the computer that makes me feel uncomfortable.
6. never use the ICT equipment in a way that maybe hurtful to others.
7. print only when my teacher tells me I may print.
8. only access my own files or my own folders.

I understand that if I do not follow these rules, I might not be able to use the ICT equipment.
