International School of Luxembourg (ISL) Students Receive Awards from Luxembourg Associations

On Thursday, 28 January, at 11:15 a.m., two Luxembourg associations – Lion’s Club and Zonta Club – will present awards to an ISL project and an ISL student at an Upper School Student Assembly.

Kili Kids Community Centre

For the past ten years, ISL International Baccalaureate (IB) students have been supporting Project Moshi in Tanzania, contributing to the construction of school dormitories in various locations. In addition to this ongoing project, in 2010, ISL students identified a new project to support: the Kili Kids Community Centre, an orphanage for abandoned children. The Lion’s Club Luxembourg will award 3700 EUR to ISL to aid with construction, electricity and plumbing for the new centre.

Young Women in Public Affairs

The Zonta Club Luxembourg, a local chapter of an international organization working to advance the status of women worldwide through service and advocacy, will award the ‘Young Women in Public Affairs’ Award to Miss Sarah McMinimy, a grade 12 student. Miss McMinimy is the second young woman to receive this prize in Luxembourg, which includes a stipend of 350 EUR. Miss McMinimy receives this prize for her service activity in Kingston, Jamaica, where she worked with inner-city children.
