**The Minister of Foreign and European Affairs, Jean Asselborn, is attending the ISL International Forum**

On Tuesday 15 May 2018 at 08:15 Jean Asselborn will give the opening speech at the ISL International Forum.

The International Forum is the culminating event to a unit of study on global issues and diplomacy for Grade 7 students at ISL.

The Forum is designed to provide the opportunity for students to understand and address solutions to critical current global issues and develop negotiating and debate skills.

Students study five critical global issues and then serve as a country delegate on one of five committees (Women's Rights, Child Labour, Drug Trafficking, Migration and Nuclear Non-proliferation) to represent that country's viewpoint and interest through a Model United Nations-style debate.

The skills they developed here will be valuable for their future occupation, not only in politics but in almost any field they choose. (The unit is based on the Model United Nations simulation, but does not purport to be a MUN.)
