ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE MUSIC SEMINAR

The founder of a start-up based in Luxembourg that develops artificial intelligence capable of composing symphonic music for films, video games and commercials is coming to speak at the International School of Luxembourg.

Founder and CEO of Aiva (Artificial Intelligence Virtual Artist) Technologies, Pierre Barreau, will be speaking about the creation and entrepreneurial aspects of his company, and the pioneering work they are doing in the field of music composition.

Aiva is an artificial intelligence capable of composing emotional music, something usually considered to be deeply human. Aiva has been learning the art of music composition by reading through a large collection of music partitions, written by the greatest composers such as Mozart, Beethoven, and Bach, to create a mathematical model representation of what music is. This model is then used by Aiva to write completely unique music.

Pierre will also be highlighting the connections Aiva Technologies has to offer other fields, such as art and film, as well as the creative aspects of artificial intelligence music making, through the lens of math's, and scientific computer technologies.
